Work Permit, Stay Permit and Other Related Permits

The followings are the permits required to be obtained by an expatriate working in Indonesia:

- 1. Approval for Expatriate Manpower Plan (RPTKA)
- 2. Recommendation Letter for the Expatriate concerned (TA.01)
- 3. Temporary Permit to enter into Indonesia
- 4. Temporary Admission Card/Stay permit Card (KIMS/KITAS)
- 5. Multiple Re-entry Exit Permit valid for 6 months and extendable once for another 6 months
- 6. Immigration Control Book (Blue Book/POA)
- Skill Development Fund (DPKK) payable to the Ministry of Manpower (transfer directly through bank to designated DPKK bank account) – DPKK is US\$100/month and payable in advance for one year, plus US\$5 provision fee
- 8. Working Permit (IKTA) valid for 1 year, and can be extended
- 9. Police Registration (SKLD)
- 10. Personal Report Certificate (STM)
- 11. Letter of Domicile (SKTT)
- 12. Registration Letter of Temporary Resident (SKPPS)
- 13. Expatriate Manpower Existence Report (Laporan Keberadaan)
